Offsite Adoption Information

Dear Adopter,

Thank you for adopting from the Bucks County SPCA. We are happy that you have found a new friend to bring home. Here is some information about your adoption:

- Once we process your adoption in our system you will receive a final adoption contract from us in the mail. There is no need to sign the contract because we will have your signed copy on file.
- You will also have a payment receipt mailed to you to keep for your records. The adoption donation is tax deductible.
- Your new pet has been spayed/altered, microchipped and vaccinated. For details on any medical care provided to your pet, including what vaccination booster or treatments may be scheduled, refer to the medical summary report inside your adoption folder. Share a copy of this report with your pet's veterinarian.
- We recommend you take your new pet to your own veterinarian in the next 7-10 days for a complete physical and additional vaccinations or treatments.
- If you are adopting a dog or cat, 24 PetWatch pet insurance programs provide you with 30 days of free pet insurance. It covers most illnesses that may occur to dogs and cats post adoption. You will receive an e-mail within 24 hours of adoption (it may take up to 48 hours for offsite adoptions to be formally processed)). Simply click on that e-mail to confirm your gift of insurance. Once confirmed, coverage will begin on the second midnight following the adoption being processed. If you have questions about this coverage please refer to www.24Petwatch.com. If you do not receive an e-mail within 48 hours of taking your pet home, please contact the shelter.
- Your adoption includes a 60 day money back guarantee, no questions asked. This gives you 60 days to make sure your new pet will settle in and work out with other pets and people in the home. If for ANY reason the new pet does not work out, we will take the pet back and refund your adoption fee for up to 60 days. After 60 days, we do not refund the fee, but will ALWAYS take an adopted pet back. Pets must be returned to the shelter instead of the offsite facility you got your pet from.
