Live Release Rate	Rate calculation = Total Live Release count / Total Intake
Total Live Release	Sum of animals returned to owner, adopted, returned to field or transferred outside the partners to agencies (that guarantee adoption of the animals transferred to them).
Total Intake	Sum of animals entering all partner agencies from non-partner sources (i.e., excludes number transferred between Dashboard-reporting partners).
Stray Intake	Animals picked up in the field or brought to shelter (by anyone) who have no known owner.
Returns (30 days)	Animals returned to shelter within 30 days of being adopted from that agency.
Return to owner (RTO)	Animals included in shelter Intake count (current or prior reporting period) that are successfully reunited with their owners (i.e. reclaimed from shelter).
Adoptions (net Returns)	Final adoptions only. It does not include animals placed in foster care, on overnight 'trial' stays, or on hold at shelter prior to completion of adoption agreement. This count also excludes animals returned within 30 days of being adopted.
